Pews Find A Second Life

A year ago, as we completed our sanctuary updates, we removed seven pews from the sanctuary to accommodate better accessibility in our pews. Following a devastating fire at Holy Innocents Church, one of the churches we have spent significant time at on the Rosebud Reservation, we reached out to see if pews could be of any help as they rebuild. We will soon be sending them off to their new home on the Rosebud where they will be used immediately as the 133-year-old congregation gathers in their Guild Hall to worship.
